CENTRA CAMPUS SAFETY AND SECURITY POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Centra Security is dedicated to providing a safe and secure atmosphere for our patients, visitors, employees and students. We take a proactive approach in addressing issues around all our facilities. Your assistance in ensuring our environment is safe and secure is essential. The following is a list of a few common safety and security precautions.

- Centra Identification badges are used for multiple purposes including:
 - Access to secured areas
 - Identification as a student
 - Logging in to POC tools such as glucometers

For safety reasons do not share your identification badge with anyone. If you lose your badge report it immediately to Centra Security.

- Avoid bringing any valuables to campus. Large sums of money or valuable property should be left at home.
- While on campus be sure to lock up any purses, wallets, and other valuable property. This includes inside of break rooms. If you do not have a place on the unit to lock up your items, contact your preceptor.
- Lock your vehicle when away from it. Even if there is nothing of “value” in the vehicle.
- When walking outside be aware of your surroundings at all times. Look around and underneath your car as you walk towards it and inside before you get in.
- Use the “buddy system” when walking out. Never walk alone. If you need an escort, contact security.
- When entering or exiting secure areas including exterior doors, ED, OR, ICU, Mother Baby, etc. ensure the door fully closes behind you. Watch to make sure no one is “piggybacking”.
- Weapons including firearms, knives, tasers, etc. are strictly prohibited on any Centra property.
- Report any suspicious activity IMMEDIATELY to Centra Security at 434-200-3255. For any Emergencies dial 911.
